Information and Guidelines

- The race will start in Hawai'i Kai at 10:00 am and finish at Kaimana Beach in Waikīkī.
- All entrants MUST be registered to participate.
- To register, BOTH the entry form and agreement must be completed and received by race coordinator.
- A non-refundable contribution must accompany entry form and agreement for registration.
- Entrants may pre-register by returning forms and check payable to "Komike Makua Punana Leo o Honolulu" to race coordinator by November 13.
- Onsite registration will be allowed on the day of the race from 8:00 am to 9:00 am in Hawai'i Kai.
- A pre-race safety meeting will be held at 9:30 am on November 22 in Hawai'i Kai. All participants MUST attend.
- Winners will be announced that day at the Kapi'olani Band Stand.
- This is a race covering a long distance in the ocean, therefore the use of a leash is HIGHLY recommended.
- The Makahiki Maoli Festival is a family event. Proper conduct is expected for everyone's safety and the safety and care of the site.
- The Makahiki Maoli Festival committee reserves the right to cancel the event due to unforeseen circumstances.

Accident Waiver and Release of Liability

I am applying for entry into Kōmike Makua Pūnana Leo o Honolulu's Makahiki Maoli Festival Heihei Wa'a. This event will be held on Sunday, November 22, 2009. I fully realize this is an event that is subject to winds, waves, tides, currents and other natural marine hazards. I also realize that by entering this race I put my self at risk to these hazards.
